Last Year Spot #: For South Beach, North Island and West Beach only. To avoid errors, provide your current spot number (Do not use “same as always”).
New Location Request: If you are requesting a spot for a new boat or a new location for your current boat, specify South, North and/or West by order of preference. If you are removing your boat from a PLA property, use “Home”. New spot allocations are done on a strict first come first served basis.

Boat Docking Policies and Procedures

- All boats, whether newly assigned or in spaces retained from the previous year, must be in the space with a current year’s decal no later than June 15. The space may be returned to the general pool of spaces open for reassignment if it was not requested, is unoccupied or does not have a current decal after that date. The space will not be available to you the following year.
- **Second spaces will be final only after all requests for first boat spaces are fulfilled. Second spaces currently assigned are subject to availability and may be revoked if needed.**
- All boats on Association property should be: tied down and locked, usable condition & set to avoid the accumulation of standing water (turned over, covered, or drain plug removed).
- Canoes or kayaks can be placed in any position on the appropriate rack at the location you were assigned (North Island, South Beach or West Beach). Please see the Boating section of the PL Membership Rules for a complete enumeration of the standards and regulations regarding the storage and operation of boats on Pines Lake.

In placing a boat on Association property, the boat owner assumes all liability for any and all claims and costs that arise out of placing, storing, or removing his or her boat.
